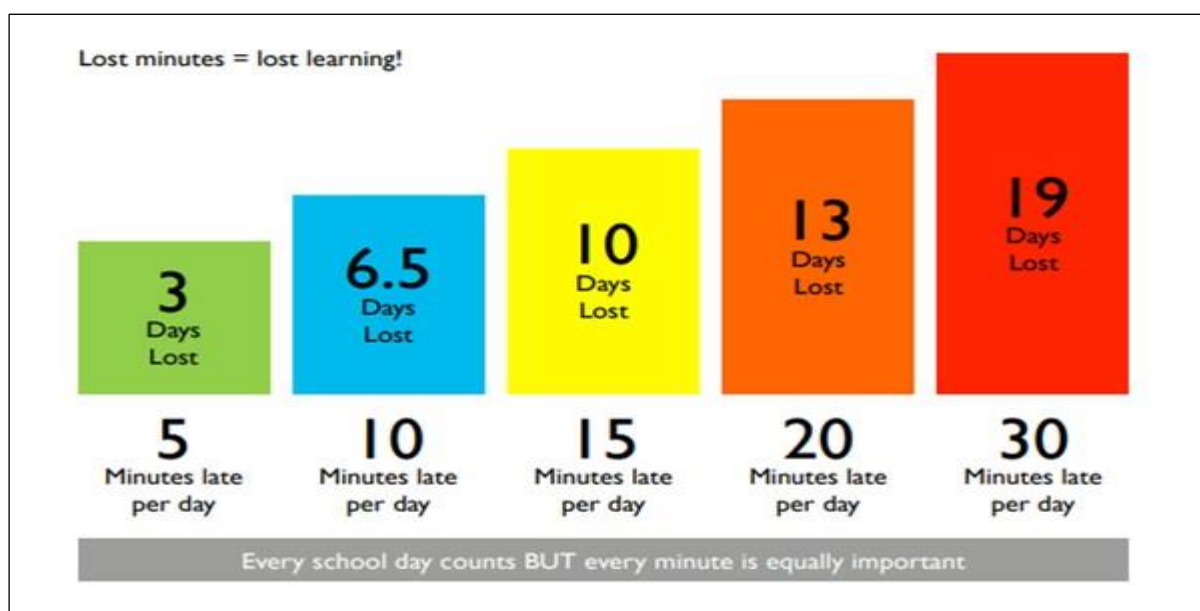

Attendance and Punctuality

School starts promptly at 08:45. Gates close at 08:45 and if children are late they must enter school via the main office. We have recently installed a new signing in and out system at the main office and this system will now be used for pupils as well as staff and visitors. From Tuesday 7th May 2024, pupils who arrive in school after the gates close at 08:45 will now have to be signed in, using the new system, by their parent/carer. Pupils leaving school early will also need to be signed out by their parent/carer. Upon signing in/out you will be required to follow the instructions on each screen which includes entering your name and providing a reason for signing in late/leaving early. Lunch options will then need to be given to the office staff. The new system has been introduced as part of the development processes in school, ensuring all pupils are appropriately accounted for and to support in attendance tracking.
