If you decide to take your child on holiday during term time you should apply in writing to the Headteacher (a form can be requested from the school office). Leave will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances.

Penalty notices can be applied for taking your child out of school during term time and **could incur a fine of £120 per child per parent for each occasion.**

Please try to arrange any medical and dental appointments at the end of the school day (after 15:15). Children are only expected to attend 190 days per year leaving 175 days for all other commitments. Attendance is monitored closely and reported to Lancashire County Council and the Department for Education termly. Children who are identified as persistent absentees will be referred to the Local Authority Attendance Consultant. Missing 10% or more of school classes a child as persistently absent (i.e. 19 school days).

School Attendance correlates directly with children's achievements and progress in school and we encourage and celebrate good and outstanding attendance.
